#### **ABOUT THE COVER**

Last season, Blake "Bo" Furcron became the ninth player for Elyria High school to earn the Lorain County Mr. Basketball award. During his senior season, the 6-foot-5 guard averaged 21.8 points, 5.9 rebounds, 3.9 assists and 2.9 steals a game. Along with Lorain County Mr. Basketball, Furcron was also named Second Team All-Ohio, First Team All-Northeast District and was the Northeast Ohio Conference Player of the Year. The former Pioneer is currently continuing his basketball career at Walsh University.

Elyria Catholic's Riley Schill became the first Panther player to ever pick up the title of Lorain County Miss Basketball in 2016. Averaging 12.1 points, five assists and 4.7 rebounds a game in her senior season, Schill helped the Panther to a 24-4 record, a Great Lakes Conference Championship and a Division II District title. The Panther's four year letter winner is now attending Baldwin Wallace where she is continuing her basketball career and majoring in pre-veterinary medicine.





# 2016-2017 Lorain County boys basketball preview

It's safe to say everyone eagerly anticipated the conclusion of a recent campaign. We had all seen and heard enough. That said, the high school basketball campaign can never get here fast enough. For me, it brings with it a sense of anticipation like no other sports season. And unlike in other arenas, I never look forward to this campaign ending. So what is about to unfold on this particular campaign trail? Let's take a look at the candidates.

In the SWC, Midview will look to defend their league title (one they shared with North Olmsted) with a new head coach. After a fabulous 19-year run, Troy DiFranco stepped aside and assistant Jim Brabanic will now guide the Middies (while Troy joins WEOL several times at the broadcast table). Midview comes off that SWC championship with some nice players back, including seniors Dustin Crum and Chris Verda and junior Vince Birth. Coach Brabanic anticipates contributions from several newcomers as well, including Gage Carnes,

Keith Johnson, Derek Rebman, Seamus Higley, Isiah Johnson, and Brandon Gilchrist. North Ridgeville made a great run to the district title game in the D1 tournament and comes off a 16 win season. Coach Bryan Morgan has some rebuilding to do, but has returnee Brian Flanagan and new varsity players MJ Smith and Jeremy Sanchez to build around. Further up Route 83 in Avon, the Eagles come off a winning season and finished just one game back in the SWC. Coach Kevin Sapara returns a dynamic talent in DelShawn Orr who averaged 15 per game as a sophomore last year, and also welcomes back starters senior Justin Ladegaard and sophomore Ryan Maloy. At Avon Lake, the Shoremen anticipate success this winter, with several returning players. Coach Eric Smith will start with veteran players such as All-County performer Jordan Ball, as well as seniors Carson Toy, Mark Papas, David Marsh, and Barris Coleman. Experience can be a recipe for a strong season. Over at Amherst, the Comets also return several performers who worked through a rocky campaign last year. Pat Bray will count on veteran guys like Johnny Matakovich, Carter Zajowski, Chad Jones, Alec Dimacchia, and Gehrig Gabrie to get the Comets on the winning side of the ledger. Like last season, the SWC promises to be a hotly contested conference, with '16 co-champion North Olmsted, Olmsted Falls, Westlake, Berea-Midpark, and Lakewood providing quality teams as well. It should be a great race.

Lorain has had back to back "Sweet 16" D1 appearances, and would love a third consecutive trip to the regional. Fresh off their 22-win season, John

Rositano returns a bevy of talented players including Naz Bohannon who averaged a double-double last year and key contributors Jalil Little, Dasean Brooks, and Shayne Smith. Devone Grant will be an exciting newcomer. The weekly showdowns in the LEL will have the Titans ready for tournament time. Lorain will showcase their talents in their glistening new gymnasium. Elyria comes off a 15-win season but was stung in the sectionals by North Ridgeville. Brett Lerrick has to replace Mr. Basketball "Bo" Furcron, but returns several letter winners, including sharp shooter and three year starter Antonio Blanton, and other starters including big men Josh Lotko and Justin Keopp and point guard Dez Brown. Other key players for the Pioneers will be Darquan Woods and Mike Oliver. Elyria will face tough tests throughout the season in the GCC.

Vermilion will play in the Sandusky Bay Conference for the first time this winter. While the competition will be rugged, Kurt Habermehl has a very experienced and deep team returning. Junior Joby Pfeil is

an outstanding talent, and seniors Drew Dawson and Nik Barkdull are terrific on the floor as well. The Sailors will make their presence felt in their new league, and are always a tough "out" come tournament time.

The PAC gave fans some great games and competitive teams last year, and this season should be no different. On the Stripes side, Clearview nipped Oberlin for the division title in '15-'16, and John Szalay's Clipper team returns some outstanding talent, including seniors Deuce Martin, DeAri Todd, and James Billings. Others expected to contribute are Sam Daniels, Evan Barrios, Owen Bansek and Javon Todd. But Oberlin is loaded as well. The Phoenix come off a District Championship and Regional Semi-Final appearance, and coach Kurt Russell will welcome back his top six scorers, seniors Donald Johnson, Caleb Houghley, Zion Hicks, David Payne, and Mark Robinson. Another fun season is in store for the Phoenix. At Columbia, Larry Babics will need to find

some scoring punch after the graduation of David Delahunty. The Raiders will welcome back three key players from last year in Taylor Beck, Jared Heidecker, and Brandon Coleman. Lutheran West, Fairview, and Brooklyn will round out the Stripes Division. In the Stars Division, **Key stone** looks to defend their division title and build off a very successful season. The Wildcats graduated some outstanding talent, but return leading scorer Brody Kuhl and starter Turner Campbell, as well as lettermen Jeremy Gerhardinger and Corey Moffat who will provide experience for Jeff Holzhauer to build around. Dan Gundert's Wellington club finished above .500 last year and has three players back who averaged in double figures, Trey Bealer,

Josh Kindle, and Max Joppeck. Add in key contributors Trevor Porter and Colton Schmidt, and this could be a terrific season for the Dukes. **Firelands** will look to build off a nine win season last year. The Falcons have two starters returning in Doc Januzzi and Colin Myers, and Firelands coach Alan Januzzi expects Nick Denney to play a key role as well. **Brookside** struggled the past couple of seasons, and they hope the arrival of veteran head coach Phil Argento will turn things around. Coach Argento expects dramatic improvement for the Cardinals led by returning players Tyler Alam, Travis Fortney, Owen Rozanc, Norman Elias, and Manny McNeill. The always tough Buckeye Bucks and the Black River Pirates are the two other teams in the Stars.

Elyria Catholic fashioned a 16 win season last year, while playing a tough league and non-conference schedule.

Coach Phil Kuchta won't watch his son Jacob perform for EC after he graduated in the spring, but some very good players who garnered a lot of playing time will be back for the Panthers, including versatile senior Doug Taylor, senior Sean Szabo, junior Dorian Crutcher, and junior Donovan Warfield. The Great Lakes Conference features some challenging matchups, including a Bay Rockets team that advanced to the Final 4 last year, so EC will be tested all season.

Independently, **Open Door** will field a very young team this season. Coach Todd Wright could have three sophomores in the starting lineup. Those 10th graders are Carter Wright, Jared Bublinec, and Trey Brooks. The Patriots will also expect key contributions from Charley Lovett, RJ Stanford and Maxx Wiley. Through sheer experience, the Patriots will improve as the year moves

along. **Lake Ridge** comes off a winning season last year, and they have a new head coach. Alan George now guides the Royals, after Brian Ansberry departed for Padua. Coach George has some solid returnees back, including senior guards Collin Harris and Kevin Moreno, and junior forward Brian Smith. **First Baptist** returns all five starters from last year so a strong season should unfold. Head coach Darren Snelling returns some terrific talent in Brett Snelling, Jovan Jones, Jonatan Collazo, and Josue Callazo

The campaign is about to start. There will be some ups and downs and highs and lows as the journey unfolds. There might even be a debate or two about players and teams. But it's a campaign that promises to be a pleasure to watch and fun to listen to over the next few months. And we can all agree, that's a campaign we will enjoy.

# 2016-2017 Lorain County girls basketball preview

The 2016-2017 Lorain County High School Girls Basketball season will see two new head coaches on the sidelines. Tony Brown takes over for Brian Arth at Elyria, and long time area coach Brian Kelley is the new head coach at Oberlin. Last season Elyria Catholic and Lake Ridge Academy were one step away from Columbus when they fell short on the same Saturday in March.

**Elyria Catholic** returns three starters from the 24-4 team that made the regional finals. Senior Nora Hopkins 8ppg, 6rpg; classmate Sam Filiaggi 8ppg, 5rpg; and junior Megan Schelibelhut 8ppg and 5rpg. Coach Eric Rothgery said Faith Williams returns to Lorain County, moving back from out of state. Eric says she will have a big impact. The Panthers' goals are big: to win more games than a year ago and get deeper in the tournament.

**Lake Ridge** went 18-7 and lost in overtime in the regional final. Key players returning are juniors Michaela Harrison and Sydney Mayberry, and senior Maria Janasko. Coach Lisa Medvetz feels defense and leadership are the keys if Lake Ridge is to defend their district crown.

Looking at the Southwestern Conference, Meghan Lerrick's **Avon Eagles** are coming off a 17-8 campaign. Senior Shaylynn Davidson, juniors Amari Davidson and Juliann Walker, and sophomore Elizabeth Flynn are key returners. Lerrick feels the SWC will be very competitive; their goal is to finish at the top of the conference. At **Amherst**, Kevin Collins' team went 16-8 (11-7 SWC), and lost in the district semifinals. Key returners include Sydney Roule, a senior; with 14.7ppg, 6.8rpg, and 3.2apg; she has verbally committed to D1 IUPUI. Senior Jayla Hall has 12.4ppg, 10.3rpg, 2.7apg; Kate Iliff has 9.7ppg, 4.1rpg; and Kamryn Dziak has 7.7ppg and 2.7apg. With so many key players

returning, Collins said the team goals are to compete for a conference and district titles. At **North Ridgeville**, Amy Esser's Rangers went 7-16 a year ago. They hope to improve on that with all five starters returning. They include senior Addysen Kerr, a two year starter with 7ppg 3.8rpg; classmate Dani Blagojevic, a key defender a year ago, and junior Isabella Geraci, who led the team in points at 12.3 and steals with 2.7. Esser looks to Izzy to have a big year. The other returning starters are junior Cianna Bright, with 7.5ppg and a team leading 9.1 rpg, and sophomore Lauren Miller, point guard and floor leader, who added 4.9ppg and 4.8rpg. At **Midview**, Coach Scott Plzak hopes to improve on a two win season a year ago. It will be tough with only two seniors and one junior on a very young team. Returning players include senior Allison Volney and sophomore Kaeli Evans. Kaeli led the team as a freshman in scoring, rebounding, and assists. At **Avon Lake**, Dave Zvara's Shoregals are coming off an 11-13 season. Zvara thinks his team and the league will be balanced and competitive. Last year, Zvara lost junior Anna Robinson and senior Madison Branch to injuries; this year they return healthy and ready to contribute. Several others return, including

seniors Sarah Hessel, Sarah Lucas, and Hannah Oehlstrom; junior Bridgett Molnar; and sophomores Allie Heschel and Amber Achladis.

Moving to the Patriot Athletic Conference last season, Scott Terry's **Keystone Wildcats** went 20-4, (15-1 PAC Stars Champs.) They return five senior starters: McKennah Peters 21ppg, the leading rebounder going to YSU; Ronni Benko 7ppg; Sammie Stefan 7ppg; Jena Copley, the team's best defender and 5ppg; and Reagan Ford. Terry's first win this year will be his 300th in his fine career. Tom Thompson's **Columbia Raiders** were the PAC Stripes Champs at 22-4 overall (15-1 PAC Stripes Champs.) Key returners include Becca Tacchite, a senior 8.8ppg; senior Rachel Tacchite; and classmates Torrie Shields and Lexi Wood; as well as junior Danielle Matzelle and sophomore Riley Thomas. Thompson's Raiders will rely on overall team speed and athleticism this year and leadership from three year starter Becca Tacchite and the core of returning seniors. At **Firelands**, Dave Kudela's Falcons had another fine season at 16-8 (12-4 PAC.) It will be a year of transition as the Falcons return one starter: Tori Grasso, a senior, 10ppg, 4rpg and 3apg. They will be young and inexperienced with only two others with any varsity experience.

They will be small but Kudela says they will be able to play many girls. Nathan Morris is back for year two at **Wellington**. They improved to 5-17 last year, and have five letter winners back. They are seniors Logan Simmons 10.4ppg, 8.2rpg and Sam Sparks 5.2ppg; junior Hope Diermyer 3.1ppg; and sophomores Alexis Lehmkuhl 5.2ppg, 7rpg and Erin Frenk. Brian Kelley inherits an **Oberlin** squad that didn't win a game last year. Returners include Aszure Chamberlin, a senior at 8.9ppg; classmate Marcalia Moore 8.4ppg, 7rpg; and junior Cameron Payne. Kelley says they need to be aggressive on both ends of the court. He has a good group of kids who are working hard and buying into the program.

**Brookside** went 9-14 and they return several players including seniors Makayla Tuck, Lauren Ackerman, Hannah Torres, and Madison Sours. Also being counted on are juniors Serena Contreras and Katlyn Vanzant. Coach Barhorst feels his team will be more physical than last season. Tuck will be in the post, Ackerman and Contreras can play inside and out. Vanzant handles the ball, Torres is a slasher, and Sours is an excellent athlete. At **Clearview**, Coach Nick Dimacchia's Lady Clippers are coming off a tough and disappointing 4-17 season. Returning are seniors Destiny

# 2016 - 2017 Lorain County wrestling preview

Lorain County has enjoyed one great high school wrestling season after another in recent years, and the upcoming one should be as good as any.

While a lot of that has to do with a wealth of talent returning, the other constant among the area's mat elite is the dedication to offseason work. Most of the county's top wrestlers were active all summer, and all over the country.

No program was busier than the Elyria Pioneers, who won a pair of state runner-up trophies last season — one in the team state duals and another at the individual state tournament.

Elyria has two returning state champions — junior Brendon Fenton won the 113-pound title last season and senior Kevin Vough won the heavyweight title in 2015 — as well as two-time state placer J.T. Brown, who placed fourth in Columbus as a sophomore and junior.

Vough was inactive during the offseason as he was rehabbing a knee injury suffered last year, but Fenton, Brown and

their teammates took part in the national duals, the national championships in Fargo, N.D., and multiple open tournaments around the Midwest.

Brown was on the Team Ohio squad that captured the Junior National Duals national championship, while Jordan

Keegan and Lewis Aguilar were members of the Ohio teams that competed in the Cadet Freestyle and Greco-Roman National Duals.

The Pioneers, who won the inaugural Greater Cleveland Conference championship last year, also have returning state qualifiers in Matt Zuckerman, Brendan Price and Josh Breeding, a state alternate in Tristan Brady and two-time district qualifiers in Jason Truxall and Cameron King.

If that wasn't enough, Elyria also has a pair of superstar freshmen joining the roster in Mick Burnett and Dylan Shawver.

Burnett — son of coach Erik Burnett — was a member of the Ohio team that competed in the Schoolboy Freestyle National Duals and won a Schoolboy Freestyle national title this summer, and Shawver was a double All-American. Both placed third in the Junior High state tour-

nament last season.

Elyria Catholic will be looking for respect in the Great Lakes Conference and they will be led by one of the most respected Division III wrestlers in the state. Senior Stan Bleich will be looking to earn his fourth trip to the state tournament and his third stop on the state podiums.

Bleich, who has won three sectional and district titles, went 1-2 as a freshman in Columbus, finished sixth as a sophomore and placed third last season. If his trend of improvement continues, he'll wrestle in the state final this season and could bring the Panthers their first state championship since Scott Burnett in 1998.

Bleich will have help in the lineup from sophomore Steve Ferguson, a returning state alternate, and 2014 district qualifier (while at Oberlin)

**Lorain** will be looking for big things from senior Aaron Huff, a returning state qualifier and sectional champion, this season. He will be joined by district qualifiers Khalil Brown and Shawn Petty.

The **Titans**, who compete in the Lake Erie League, also have LEL champions Blake Bartlome and Daniel Findley, and a transfer from Shaw in Tyler Casey to help fill out the lineup.

Several area teams will be looking to unseat Olmsted Falls as Southwestern Conference champion this year, and Midview tops the list.

The **Midview Middies** will be led by state qualifier Alec Forrer, who qualified to Fargo in Greco this summer, state alternate Seth Frambach and district qualifiers Zak Anderson, Trever Begin, Jacob Snider, Spencer Berthold and Evan Keyse.

Anderson and Berthold also competed at the nationals in Fargo, and the Middies have seven freshmen that qualified to the Junior High state tournament last season.

**Avon** also has a solid core returning, led by state qualifier Tate Zeman and district qualifier Tommy Sear. Zeman, Alec Walker and Kyle Burgess — as well as Midview's Berthold — were part of the area team that competed in the Ashland University Duals

earlier in the summer.

**Amherst** will also have a returning state qualifier in heavyweight Matt Lee, and will get help from two-time district qualifier Alex Reyes and district qualifier T.J. Rau-pach.

**North Ridgeville's** top wrestler should be returning state alternate Liam Schill, and the **Rangers** have a handful of wrestlers who've shown moments of greatness last season and may be the next to step up for the program.

While **Avon Lake** has no returning state or district qualifiers, the **Shoremen** have over 40 wrestlers in their program this year and will be looking toward the leadership of seniors Jack Long and Tristen Olivencia.

**Vermilion** will officially be a member of the Sandusky Bay Conference this season, and the **Sailors** have three district qualifiers — Trevor Boyd, Tyler Bath, Justin See (2015) — and a pair of district alternates — Alex Matos and Jakob Koleszar — that should help them compete right away.

While **Firelands** will be under new leadership — Josh Malave left to become the head wrestling coach at the University of Mount Union — but it will still be a heavy favorite to defend its first Patriot Athletic Conference championship.

If working hard during the offseason is a recipe for success, **Falcons** heavyweight Sean Lipscomb will accomplish a lot of great things this season. Lipscomb — a district qualifier and sectional champion last season — competed with Team Ohio at the Cadet Freestyle and Greco-Roman National Duals, and was a Freestyle and Greco-Roman nationals qualifier at Fargo.

**Firelands** will also have three-time district qualifier Larry Verhovec, two-time district qualifiers Connor Eckman, Miguel Morell, Patric Keown and Douglas Childers, and district qualifier Jason Norwood and Nick McCrary

in the lineup.

As if that weren't enough, the **Falcons** will also have a star freshman in Payton Burgdorf, who wrestled at the National Duals and at Fargo this summer.

The other returning area state qualifier in the PAC belongs to **Brookside**. Senior Brad Huhn was a two-time district qualifier before breaking through to Columbus last season.

Huhn's top teammate should be Greg Packard, a two-time district qualifier who placed sixth at the district tournament last season after winning a sectional championship.

The **Cardinals** also have returning district qualifiers in Cody Nusbaum, David Ocasio, Chas Jackson and Jacob Stoehr, and will be under the direction of former assistant coach Seth Houston this year.

**Columbia** also boasts three-time district qualifiers in Zak Shaffer and Josh Newman, who was a state alternate last season and a sectional champion in 2015.

The **Raiders** also have returning district qualifiers in Troy Cassidy and Mike Jacobucci, who was a sectional champion last year.

Not to be outdone, the **Wellington Dukes** have a slew of district qualifiers back in the fold, led by two-time district qualifiers Colin Shaffstall

and Max Mohrman.

Joining the pair are district qualifiers Mason Wright, Chris Miller, Nick Fox and Dawson Hammer (2015).

**Keystone** has made a tradition of highlighting superstar brothers, and Justin Ocheltree is hoping to match older brother Ben in earning a trip to the state tournament. Ocheltree was a district qualifier last season and a Freestyle national qualifier at Fargo.

Ben Ocheltree placed seventh at 195 pounds at the Division II state tournament last season.

The **Wildcats** also return a pair of district qualifiers in David McCullough and Garrett Coe (2015), and will be looking for big things out of senior leaders Clay Todd and Tyler Elliott as well as junior Jaret Bender.

**Clearview** and **Oberlin** each have one returning district qualifier in this year's lineup. For the **Clippers**, it's heavyweight J.D. McCardle, and Robert Bouchonville will anchor the **Phoenix's** lineup.

While it's too soon to say Lorain County will enjoy its greatest high school wrestling season during the upcoming months, it's a safe bet to say area fans will be treated to world-class wrestling, a solid group of state qualifiers and probably a state champion or two.


