Naz Bohannon: Lorain's Naz Bohannon graces the cover of the 2017 – 2018 Winter Forecast magazine as the 2017 Lorain County Mr. Basketball Award winner.

During his senior year with the Titans, Bohannon averaged 17 points, 9.1 rebounds and 4.6 assists while helping lead the his team to a 23-3 record and a trip to the District Championship Game.

Along with earning the Mr. Basketball honors, the 6-foot-6 forward was named to the AP All-Ohio First team, and was the Northeast Lakes District Player of the Year.

This season, the former Titan will play college basketball at Youngstown State University.

McKenah Peters & Sydney Roule: The 2016-2017 girls basketball season gave us co-recipients of the Lorain County Miss Basketball Award for just the fourth time in the history of the honor. Keystone's McKenah Peters and Amherst's Sydney Roule both took home the award for their outstanding senior seasons.

McKenah Peters finished her career with the Wildcats as the school's all-time leading scorer at 1,907 points. In the process of setting that record, Peters also set a county record with 241 career three point baskets. Her senior season she averaged 25.2 points and seven rebounds a game.

This season, Peters will join Naz Bohannon as she continues her playing career alongside Lorain County's Mr. Basketball at Youngstown State University.

In her final season with the Comets, Sydney Roule earned the honor of Lorain County Miss Basketball by averaging 20 pints, 6.5 rebounds, 2.8 steals and 2.8 assists. At the free throw line she hit an impressive 86 percent of her shots.

This season, Roule will continue her playing career at Indiana University - Purdue University in Indianapolis.

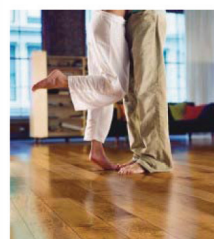

Lorain County Boys Basketball Preview

It's time to get indoors. It's time to hear the dribble of the basketball off the hardwood and the squeak of the shoes on the floor. It's time to not only hear the sounds of the game taking place but the noise of the pep bands, the cheerleaders and the fans in the bleachers. Indeed, it's time. Let's play some basketball! But before the games get started, let's find out about the teams in our area as the '17-'18 season is about to unfold.

We start with **Elyria Catholic**, a team that has been eagerly anticipating this season for a while. Phil Kuchta's club comes off a very successful 16-7 campaign that included a Great Lakes Conference championship. The Panthers return some very talented players. Senior Dorian Crutcher led Lorain County at 22 points per game last season and was an All-Ohio selection. Junior Jarred Logan was a presence inside, and three sophomores who saw action as freshmen, Edward Wright II, Brendan Holley and Branson Taylor will all make significant contributions. The GLC is a rugged league (Bay, Holy Name and Parma to name a few conference opponents) and EC has loaded up the non-conference schedule with a bevy of very strong teams, so the Panthers will be battle tested come tournament time.

Across town, **Elyria** had a magi-

cal 21-5 season and a run to the Sweet 16 last March before succumbing in the regional semi-final to Toledo St. John 48-47. A controversial non-call on Pioneer star Antonio Blanton as he attempted a game winning shot at the buzzer kept Elyria from a trip to the Elite 8. Not only does coach Brett Larrick look to replace Blanton, but several other players as well. The Pioneers return one starter in post player Justin Koepp, and will look to fill in the pieces around him. Returnee Devian Williams should be a key contributor, but the Pioneers will be an inexperienced team. Playing in the very competitive Greater Cleveland Conference will make things challenging for Elyria.

Let's head west, where the **Vermilion** Sailors are coming off a tremendous year. Kurt Habermehl's club won a share of the Bay Division championship in the Sandusky Bay Conference and finished 17-6. Vermilion is gearing up for another strong campaign, as three starters return, Jonah and Joby Pfeil, along with Mason Montgomery.

There should be some terrific action in the Patriot Athletic Conference this year. On the Stripes side, **Clearview** looks to defend their division championship. John Szalay has some talented players returning from an 18-5 squad, including seniors Sam Daniels and Gee Newton and junior Javon

Todd. **Oberlin** graduated a slew of players off a team that went 19-6 and was district runner-up in Division 3 last year. Kurt Russell will attempt to find pieces to utilize around returnee Devan Yarber. For **Columbia**, their basketball fortunes were impacted during the football season when Brandon Coleman suffered a knee injury. Coleman will be out for the hoops campaign as well. Coach Larry Babics returns a couple of key players in senior Josh Borling and sophomore Caleb Elsesser. A very solid Fairview team, along with Lutheran West and Brooklyn, will round out the Stripes. On the Stars side, **Buckeye** is the defending champion. **Wellington** was runner up in the division last year as Dan Gundert's team fashioned a 14-win season. With the likes of four-year lettermen Max Jopeck and Colton Schmidt returning, along with Ryan Whitaker, the Dukes could make some noise in '17-'18. **Keystone** comes off a 10-win year, and with head coach Jeff Holzhauser welcoming back solid veterans Brody Kuhl, Kevin Meal-

witz and Jeremy Gerhardinger, the Cats could be primed for an excellent season. **Firelands** graduated several players off a 13-win team last year. Falcons coach Alan Januzzi will look for the components to place around his lone returning starter in Nick Denney, a terrific talent on the hardwood. Aaron Myers and Richard Maggard saw action for Firelands last year as well. At **Brookside**, head coach Phil Argento continues the process of building the Cardinal program. He hopes to take some strides forward this season with some talented players expected to contribute including Norm Elias, Jacob Cole and Manny McNeil. The Black River Pirates will round out the Stars Division.

It was another great basketball season in **Lorain** last winter, as the Titans finished 23-3, but a stinging loss to Elyria in the district final ended the campaign. Mr. Basketball Award winner Naz Bohannon is now at Youngstown State, and Lorain also graduated their four other starters, but John

Rositano reloads with key contributors from last year returning, including Devone Grant, Taevon Pierre-Louis, and Davion Dower. The Titans have their sights set on a return trip to the Sweet 16, but will need to navigate a tough LEL Conference before tournament time arrives.

Independently, **Open Door** finished 10-13 last season, and Coach Todd Wright has very high hopes for this year. The Patriots return seniors Max Wiley and RJ Sanford and three players who started as sophomores last year, including Trey Brooks (the 2017 Lorain County Division 4 Player of the Year), Jared Bublinec and Carter Wright. At **Lake Ridge Academy**, it was a bumpy ride last year, but the Royals expect success in '17-'18. Head coach Alan George returns veteran players Cole Bramhall, Austin Bramhall and Brian Smith, and expects contributions from newcomers Matt South and Matt Harrington. **First Baptist** is a non OHSAA member school but still competes on the hardwood in the Ohio Christian Schools Athletic

Association. Last year, the Sabres compiled an outstanding 20-10 mark and expect another banner season this year. Coach Darren Snelling returns stalwarts Jonatan Collazo, Josue Collazo, Carson Odle and Ebewka Ojewku.

An incredible race in the SWC unfolded last year, and when the dust settled, it was **Avon** who emerged as champions. The Eagles graduated five senior starters and then lost key returnee Vlas Pappas for this season to a football injury, but Kevin Sapara will still have excellent players to utilize in Ryan Maloy, Jacob Chasteen and Jake Parker. **Avon Lake** had a 16-win season last year, and Coach Eric Smith expects another successful campaign this winter. Three-year starter Jordan Ball returns for the Shoremen, and big man Luke Martinsen will be a major presence in the paint. At **Midview**, second year head coach Jim Brabenic will look for a bounce back season after the Middies slid below .500 last year. The Middies return some nice pieces to build around in Gage Carnes as well as Vince Birth and Seamus Higley. Just up the road at **North Ridgeville**, the Rangers too will look to rebound from a tough season a year ago in

which the team only won six games. Coach Bryan Morgan has an excellent returnee in senior guard MJ Smith and junior Jeremy Sanchez will be a key contributor as well. At **Amherst**, The Comets will look for improvement off a three-win season. The good news for Coach Pat Bray is some younger players gained some valuable experience last year and now look to build off that playing time. Returnees include seniors Alec Dimacchia and Gehrig Gabriele, while Troy Toth will con-

tribute as well. The remaining five teams in the SWC form an incredibly competitive conference. Olmsted Falls will be a force. Westlake should be competitive. Berea-Midpark is always formidable. North Olmsted is a challenging opponent and Lake-wood provides solid competition. There is never an off night in the SWC.

It is indeed that time to lace 'em up and go. Let's get inside and enjoy the sights and sounds of high school hoops. Let's play some basketball!

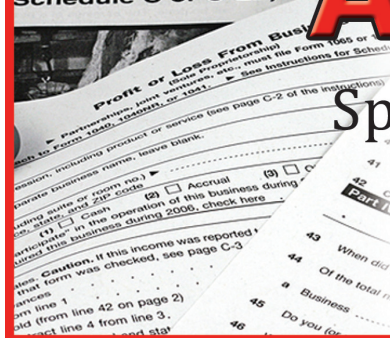

The '17 - '18 Lorain County high school girls basketball season will see three new coaches on the sidelines. Longtime boy's assistant at Midview, Rob Overy, takes on the top spot for the girls at Midview. Former Avon Lake JV coach Yvonne Craigo is the new head coach at Vermilion and former Hiram College standout Tiffany Shields is the new head coach at Oberlin.

Looking at the county schools in the SWC, **Amherst Steele** was 19-5 (15-3 SWC) a year ago. Kevin Collins returns Kate Iliff, a four year starter, along with Kamryn Dziak, a three year starter. Facts about Marijuana and Lorain County Youth

In 2016, Communities That Care of Lorain County surveyed 2231 students from 13 public school districts in Lorain County. Substance use is down, in Lorain County and nationally, for youth! Still concerning, however, is that the perception of risk for substances, especially marijuana, is decreasing. This finding means that less students feel that it is risky to use marijuana. The perception of risk drops significantly from 8th to 10th grade. Only half of 10th graders report perception that using marijuana is dangerous. In addition, only 86% of 10th graders perceive that their parents feel that marijuana use is a risk. When students are using marijuana, the survey finds that they are using at a friend's house on the weekends. Over 35% of 10th graders feels that marijuana is fairly easy or very easy to get.

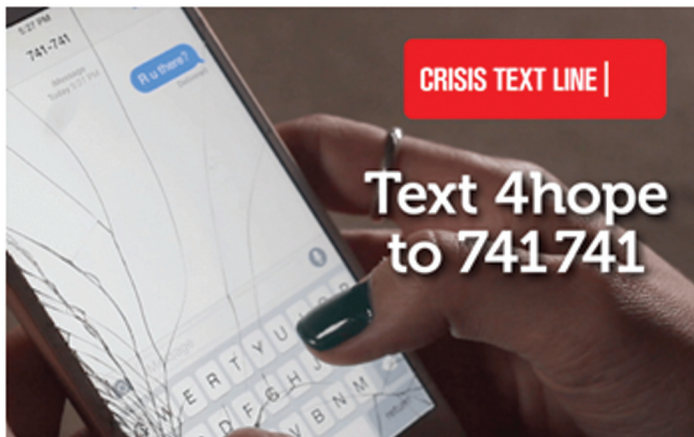
Tips for parents:

- Educate yourself on the risks of substance use for teens
- Talk with your kids about the dangers of using drugs and alcohol
- Set clear rules and expectations
- Encourage participation in school and community activities

Tips for Healthy Lorain County Kids:

Lorain County youth are spending an increased amount of time on electronic devices. Reports of screen time of five or more hours on a school day increase from 15% of 6th graders to over 30% for 10th graders. This screen time does not include school work. Examples include social media, video games, and streaming videos — all factors that can impact a young person's mental health. Screen time takes time away from engaging in physical activity, making good grades, school activities, and community engagement.

The good news is that the majority of Lorain County students are getting some physical activity throughout the week. Over half of 6th, 8th, and 10th graders are getting five or more days of physical activity a week, and less than 10% are getting zero days for all three grades. This is a great sign because physical activity is a protective factor for the overall wellness of the child. The positive factor of physical activity is

stable across all grades and is something that students are already highly engaged in.

Another measure of wellness is healthy eating behavior. We are seeing higher fruit and vegetable consumption in the younger students - almost 20% of 6th graders are reporting four or more fruit and vegetable servings a day. Unfortunately, consumption falls for both fruits and vegetables for 8th through 10th graders.

Tips:

- Limit screen time and encourage participation in school and community activities
- Encourage youth to find physical activities that they enjoy and can participate in regularly
- Offer fruits and vegetables as snack choices. Older adolescents tend to grab what is easy. Help make the healthy choice the easy choice!

“Not my kid”: Protect your family from a suicide tragedy

Your child is active in sports. Healthy. Happy. Connected. When you see reports about youth suicide, you think, “Not my kid.” The truth is, many parents who have lost their children to suicide have thought the same thing.

With social media and TV shows that graphically depict suicide, our kids are thinking about, talking about, and even attempting suicide at younger ages. In Lorain County, 9% of sixth grade students reported attempting suicide in the last year. Kids are NOT talking to parents about this. Only 14.5% of sixth graders who reported feeling depressed or suicidal also said they discussed this with a parent, and that percentage gets lower the older a kid gets.

It is time for parents to be part of the suicide conversation. Asking about suicide does not “plant a seed.” Find out more about how to ask your son or daughter “Are you thinking about killing yourself?” and the reasons it is important by watching these videos:

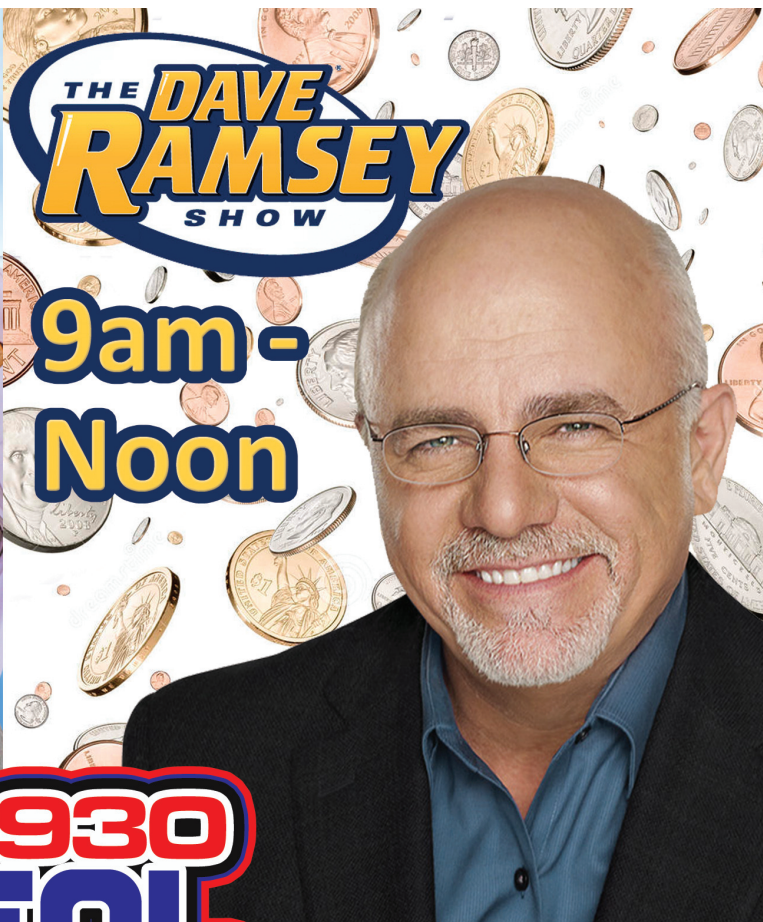

Lorain County High School Wrestling Preview

Area high school wrestling fans have been blessed for decades, as Lorain County seems to reload with talent year after year with no end in sight.

This season will be no different, except that the returning class will be led by Elyria senior Brendon Fenton, who will be just the third wrestler in county history to return with two state championships under his belt.

The last to do it was Scott Burnett, who won state titles his final three years (1996-98) at Elyria Catholic. The only other wrestler to do it is Fenton's coach and Scott's brother, Erik Burnett, who remains the lone wrestler from a Lorain County school to win four state championships (1984-87).

Like the Burnetts, Fenton will attempt to become a four-time state qualifier and state placer. Scott Burnett finished fifth his freshman season, while Fenton, who has committed to Eastern Michigan University, placed seventh as a freshman.

Fenton has also won a pair of conference titles, placed twice at the Brecksville Holiday tournament, placed three times at the Bill Dies Memorial and is a two-time member of the Ohio team that competed in the freestyle nationals.

Joining Fenton in the lineup will be senior Josh Breeding - a Princeton University commit who is a two-time state qualifier and placed fifth at the Division I state tournament last season - two-time state qualifier Matt Zuckerman, state placers Dylan Shawver and Mick Burnett, and district Brendon Fenton qualifiers Jim Schill and Lewis Aquilar.

As if that weren't enough, Elyria will also be bolstered by the addition of Farouq Muhammed - a junior transfer from Shaker Heights who was a state placer as a freshman and state alternate last year, but will have to sit the first half of the season due to transfer rules - freshman Jake Evans - a junior high state champion and Super 32 middle school champ - and freshmen Colin Noel - a junior high state qualifier - and Enrique Munguia - a Philo placer.

Even though Elyria is probably the team to beat in the county again, the Pioneers aren't alone when it comes to top-tier returning talent.

That list is headed up by Amherst senior heavyweight Matt Lee, who is not only a preseason projection to reach the Division I state final, but could become the

Comets' first state champion - and second all-time - since Jake Percival in 2000.

Lee is a two-time state qualifier who finished fifth in Columbus last season. He will join a pair of returning district qualifiers - Adam Lough last season and T.J. Raupach in 2016 - in leading Amherst.

Speaking of Percival, he's moving to Olmsted Falls as an assistant coach while Mike Wearsch, a 2013 state qualifier for Amherst and Lorain High assistant the last two years, will take his place.

The other returning state placer from the county is Firelands sophomore Payton Burgdorf, who shrugged off an injury and the fact that he was left off the state rankings to finish fourth in Division II.

Burgdorf is joined by three-time district qualifier Sean Lipscomb, two-time district qualifier Connor

Eckman and district qualifiers Colin Ransom and Jason Norwood in the lineup.

The Falcons are one of several county programs that will have a new coach, as Josh Walbom, a nationally ranked Greco wrestler who competed at Kent State and Tiffin University, will take over the reins from Dan Ransom, who will continue as an assistant.

Midview senior Seth Frambach was a Division I state qualifier last season and a state alternate in 2016. He is joined by a pair of state alternates - Zak Anderson and Trever Begin - a two-time district qualifier - Jacob Snider - and four district qualifiers - James Hutchinson, Andrew Pillion, Pablo Cruz and Daniel Bucknavich.

Four Middies wrestlers - Pillion,

Anderson, Begin and Aria Snyder, who didn't compete due to a separated shoulder - qualified for the nationals in Fargo, N.D., last summer.

Black River senior Jacob Campbell was a state qualifier last season, a district placer in 2016 and a state alternate as a freshman. He's joined by district placer and two-time district qualifier Zach Lahood, two-time district qualifier Joey Duche and district qualifier Noah Orelano.

Black River also welcomes three freshmen - Tommy Yourich, Hunter Yeaples and Shacoy Steele - who were middle school state

qualifiers last season.

Keystone senior Justin Ocheltree was a state qualifier last season and a district qualifier in 2015. He is looking to join brother Ben - seventh place in 2016 - as a state placer.

Ocheltree is joined in the lineup by two-time district placer and 2017 state alternate David McCullough, district qualifier Randy Harle and a quartet of freshmen - Hudson Hall, Jose Morales, Travis McCullough and Nick Hickman - who were middle school state qualifiers last season.

Rounding out the returning state qualifiers is **Vermilion** senior Tyler Bath, who also was a district qualifier in 2016. Bath has nine fellow letterwinners returning with him, including two-time district quali-

fier Trevor Boyd and district qualifier Brandon D'Edigio.

The Sailors also receive a boost from new assistant coach Mike Repko, who was a 2014 Division II state runner-up as a senior at Vermilion.

Avon senior Tate Zeman was one match shy of the Division I state tournament last season, but was a state qualifier in 2016 and a district qualifier as a freshman. He is joined by two-time district qualifier and 2017 district placer Tommy Sear; district qualifiers Alec Walker, Jordan Greer and Jack Roesch; and a trio of freshmen - Ethan Sear, Cael Saxton and Cade Robertson - who were middle school state qualifiers last season. Saxton and junior Luke Masisak qualified to the Fargo nationals this summer.

The Eagles are also under new direction, as assistant coach Jeremy Johnson, a state champion at Brecksville and two-time All-American at Ohio University, takes over.

Another new coach will be Scott Marion at **Elyria Catholic**, who will pair with Joe Bockmore to run the Panthers program. Both were former Wellington standouts.

Marion is a recently retired MMA professional fighter who has served as a wrestling coach all over the country, and Bockmore was a state placer for the Dukes in 2005 before competing for Edinboro University.

The Panthers are led by junior Steven Ferguson, a two-time Division III state alternate.

The county's last new coach is Gary Huff at **Oberlin**. Huff takes over for longtime coach Craig Enos, who retired last season, and has 2016 district qualifier - junior Robert Bouchonville - in his lineup.

Lake Erie League power **Lorain** has a trio of district qualifiers in its lineup this season. Senior Brando Inchaurregui was a Division I district qualifier last season, while seniors Khalil Brown and Shawn Petty were district qualifiers in 2016.

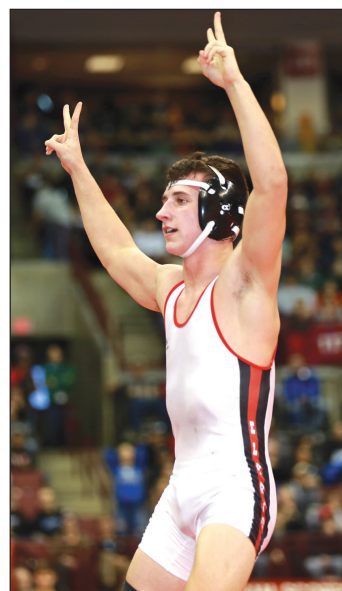
Avon Lake is looking to make some noise in the Southwestern Conference. The Shoremen are led by a quartet of district qualifiers - Alec Negron, Abud Salem, Chris Stepak and Max Wittman - a trio of district alternates - Evan Spensley, Will Danniger and J.D. Lang and Jake Burger.

Wellington has been one of the top programs in the Patriot Athletic Conference since its inception, and the Dukes will be powered by a pair of two-time district qualifiers in Mason Wright and

Colin Shaffstall, and a returning district qualifier in Tyler Wilfong.

Another recent PAC power is **Brookside**, which also has a two-time district qualifier in Jacob Stoehr. He will be joined by 2016 district qualifiers Cody Nusbaum, David Ocasio and Chas Jackson.

The PAC will sport one other two-time district qualifier in **Clearview** senior J.D. McCardle, who went 37-5 last season and is ranked No. 7 in the state in Borofanohio.net's preseason rankings. 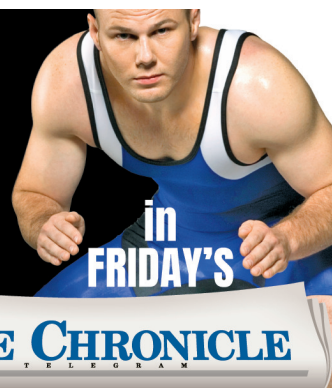
