

About the Cover:

Izzy Geraci: Featured in the large image on this year's cover is 2017-2018 Lorain County Miss Basketball award winner Isabella Geraci.

In her four seasons with the North Ridgeville Rangers, Geraci became the school all-time leading scorer with 1,220 career points. In her senior season, the Rangers stand out also earned All-Ohio Second-Team honors with an average of 17.1 points, 8.2 rebounds, 3.8 steals and 2.4 assists a game.

This year, Geraci will become the first woman's basketball player from North Ridgeville High School to play at a NCAA Division I program when she suits up for the Cleveland State Vikings.

Dorian Crutcher: Elyria Catholic's Dorian Crutcher also graces the cover of this year's Winter Forecast Magazine as the 2017-2018 Lorain County Mr. Basketball Award winner.

During his senior year, the Panthers' guard re-wrote Elyria Catholics record books with 84 three-pointers and 1,287 career points. Crutcher led Elyria Catholic all season long with a career-high 24.3 points per game.

Along with earning the Mr. Basketball honors, Crutcher was also an honor roll student at Elyria Catholic carrying a 4.0 GPA throughout his senior year.

This season Crutcher will play for the Marauders of Central State, an NCAA Division II school in Wilberforce, Ohio.







2018-2019 Lorain County Boy's Basketball Preview

The 2017-2018 boys high school basketball season was one for the history books for local fans when the Lorain Titans caught fire in March, stunned the so-called experts with two monumental wins at the regional level, and roared to the Final Four in Columbus, before falling in the state semi-final. Lorain became the 20th Lorain County boys' basketball team and the first since the 2003 Open Door Patriots to advance to the Final Four. Can Lorain make it back? Can a different county team join the likes of Lorain, Open Door, Elyria, Elyria Catholic, Clearview, Lorain Catholic, Admiral King and Oberlin who have accomplished the journey to "the big dance"? The next 100 days will answer those questions but the journey will no doubt be a fun one.

Lorain's Final Four trip was a remarkable accomplishment, and they return several key pieces to make another deep tournament run. That said, while another appearance in Columbus is the goal, it will be a daunting challenge. Yet, when John Rositano's team takes the floor this year, returning starters Devon Grant, Taevon Pierre-Louis, Jordan Jackson and Kam Davis will form a solid, tournament tested nucleus. This group of Titans walked off the floor at Value City Arena vowing a return in March of '19. They have the ingredients and mindset to make another trip a reality.

Another team returning terrific talent is Elyria Catholic, but there will be a new head coach guiding the EC program. Rob Palmer moves up from the assistant

coach's chair, replacing Phil Kuchta to lead the Panther program. While EC looks to replace the 2018 Mr. Basketball winner Dorian Crutcher, seniors Jarred Logan and David Griffin, along with juniors Edward Wright and Branson Taylor form a great core to start with. EC won 12 games last year, but the Panthers know battling in the tough Great Lakes Conference and a demanding non-conference schedule will have them tournament ready

come March.

The always competitive SWC should offer a spirited race and entertaining games again this season. At Midview, the Middies come off a 14-win season and gave Lorain a real tussle in the D1 District Semi-Final. Head coach Jim Brabenec returns a starter in junior Jonny Manning, as well as veterans Marcel Young and Isiah Johnson.

North Ridgeville put together a 12-12 year last season, and head coach Bryan Morgan will count on

three-year starter Jeremy Sanchez as well as returning seniors Tyler Cadle and Mikey Richmond to keep the Ranger program moving in the right direction.

At Avon, the Eagles come off a solid 12-win season, in which they played very well during the second half of the year. Kevin Supara will return a very experienced team, led by a terrific trio of seniors in Ryan Maloy, Dean Emerine and Jake Parker.

Avon Lake also had double digit wins last season (13-11) and coach Eric Smith welcomes back four starters in Cole Schraff, Nick Marsh, Nate Sidloski and Tanner Russell as well as veterans Creed Bologna, Hunter Simons, and Christian Perry. That has the makings of a successful season for the Shoremen.

At Amherst, the Comets have struggled in the win-loss column the past couple of years, but coach Pat Bray believes this could be the year where that pattern is broken. Amherst welcomes back veterans Ryan Hritsko, Kyle Ferguson, Christian Pfeiffer who all started last year, as well as lettermen Gavin Darmos, Matt Fairchild, Alex Karohl, and Scott Iliff.

Olmsted Falls and Lakewood waged a terrific battle for SWC supremacy last year and are expected to field outstanding teams again this season. The Bulldogs and Rangers are always among those at the top of the league. Westlake made a late off-season coaching change with Freeman Blade now guiding the Demons so this may be a transition campaign, while Berea-Midpark and North Olmsted will

round out the league.

Elyria dipped below .500 last year, finishing at 10-13 after winning the D1 district championship a year before. The Pioneers will need to replace a considerable amount of point production, as their top three scorers graduated. Coach Brett Lerrick will rely heavily on promising sophomore guard Marsaun Robinson who played significant minutes as a freshman, as well as senior guard Caleb Rogers and senior Will Waddell to make the Pioneers a competitive presence in the Greater Cleveland Conference. The weekly grind of opponents such as Solon, Mentor, Brunswick and Shaker Heights make the GCC a formidable challenge throughout the season.

The third team from Elyria is **Open Door**. Patriots coach Todd Wright is tremendously excited for this season as his team returns the top three scorers from a club that went 12-12 last year before dropping a tough district final game to Rittman. D4 Player of the Year and First Team All-Ohio player Trey Brooks comes back for Open Door

as do senior starters Jared Bublinec and Carter Wright. Another senior returnee is Caleb Daniel and a newcomer to Open Door is Miles Hunt, a Division 1 college prospect. This has the makings of a very special year for the Patriots.

The Patriot Athletic Conference is in its' final year, and as always, there should be some entertaining basketball on both the Stars and Stripes sides of the league. In the Stars, Wellington, Keystone, and Buckeye waged a great war last

year that went down to the final night before the Cats won the division.

Keystone finished the season red-hot to capture the title, and they will look to keep that momentum rolling into this year. Wildcats head coach Jeff Holzauer welcomes back a slew of talented players, including Kevin and Matt Mealwitz, point guard Ethan Sokolowski, and senior Ashton Waite to build around in the quest for another division championship.

Even though they came up short in the Stars, **Wellington** still had a terrific year in '17-'18 and with three starters returning in guards Ryan Whitaker, Noah Diermyer and Mason McCllelan, Duke head coach Dan Gundert has a tremendous nucleus to build around.

At **Firelands**, the Falcons played a bevy of underclassmen last season, and struggled through a tough campaign on the win-loss side while those young players gained valuable experience. Coach Alan Januzzi will rely on senior Austin Urban, junior Jacob Schmitz and sophomores Alex Angle and Casey Kelley to lead Firelands through the '18-'19 campaign.

Brookside has a new head coach. Cory Emerine now guides the Cardinals, after serving as an assistant coach at Elyria. Emerine will have three senior players in Jacob Cole, Connor Baughman and Cody Mortenson to provide an experienced presence, as well as junior Tyler Horvath. Buckeye and Black River will round out the Stars.

On the Stripes side, **Clearview** comes off another successful sea-

son, winning the division title, and racking up 17 wins. Head coach John Szalay will have a deep team, with several players contributing including high scoring Javon Todd, Jaylen Paschel, Josiah Hitchens, and Dylan Rebman.

Oberlin plans on making a run at the Stripes this season. Kurt Russell returns some talented ballplayers for the Phoenix, including two juniors in Giles Harrell and Aaron Hopkins, and sophomore standout Trajen Chambers.

Another team that hopes to challenge in the Stripes is **Columbia**. Coach Larry Babics will be counting on veterans Jared Byczynski, Adam Ross, and the Colemans (Bailey and Brandon) to keep the Raiders in the hunt throughout the campaign. Brandon Coleman's return to the hardwood after missing last season due to a football injury suffered during the '17 season will be a major addition to the Columbia lineup. Fairview, Lutheran West, and Brooklyn will round out the Stripes.

A team that everyone loves to watch (except their opponents) is **Vermilion**. Kurt Habermehl's Sailor squad competes for every second of a ballgame. Vermilion returns several players off a club that went 20-5 last year, including Mason Montgomery, Jonah Pfeil, Reese Miller and Luke Pena. The Sailors believe Seth Hurd can join the club at some point during the campaign, after he suffered an injury during the football season. Vermilion will again be battle tested competing in the Sandusky Bay Conference.

Lake Ridge Academy and First Baptist compete in the Lake Effect Conference and both clubs fielded competitive teams last season. Darren Snelling led First Baptist to a 14-11 year, and the Sabres return some terrific talent off that team, including seniors Josue Collazo and Ebucka Ojukwa as well as junior forward Carson Odle. For **Lake Ridge**, Royals head coach Alan George will rely on returning juniors Austin Bramhall, Matt South and Matt Harrington to keep the program pointed in the right direction, after a 9-12 season last year.

As the '17-'18 season was about to start, not many thought Lorain County would have a Final Four team. Will it happen again in '18-'19? "Let's play some basketball" and find out.



2018 Lorain County Girls High School Preview

Just like a season ago, the '18-'19 Lorain County girls basketball season will see three new coaches on the sidelines. Jay Valadez is at Amherst Steele; Vaughn K. Jones at Open Door, and Corey Taylor takes over at Columbia. What isn't known is will the county have a team make it to Columbus this year like Elyria Catholic did a year ago.

Let's begin with a look at Lorain County schools in the SWC. At Amherst Steele they will try to improve on a 10-12 overall record. Key returners are Georgia State recruit senior Kamryn Dziak. Also guards Faith Lewis, a junior, and senior Audrey McConihe. Coach Valadez says they expect to compete in every game and Kamryn Dziak will lead the Comets on and off the court. Valadez says they will rely on her leadership and maturity.

At Avon, Meghan Lerrick's team was 14-10; the Eagles graduated four starters from that squad so they won't have the experience of a year ago. They return senior Elizabeth Flynn and junior Ashlee Tornert, among others. Lerrick says they will continue to play aggressive defense and hope to improve their offense so they can put together a better all-around game.

North on Rt. 83 at Avon Lake, Coach Dave Zvara proclaims that depth, speed and experience will be strengths for the Shoregals. They are coming off a 15-10 campaign. Some of the experienced seniors include Amber Achladis, Allie Heschel, Liz Murdock, and Kelsey Simmerly. Zvara feels they should be competitive in a league that is a challenge every night. Zvara adds the talent in the SWC is similar to last year with several girls in the league committed to playing college basketball in the future.

Rob Overy returns for year two at Midview. They were 5-18 last year; Overy says the Middies return all five starters and some top bench players. Expectations are higher than they've been in awhile. He thinks the experience along with young talent that is improving should help Midview. Some key returners include Kaeli Evans, Hailey Vettel, and Mackenzie Cline.

Brookside. Last season the Cardinals were 7-16. Head Coach Brad Barhorst who enters his fourth season at the reigns this year says they want to be aggressive and physical, and have worked hard in the off season. They have several key returners; some of them are Ashley Wallace, Tori Aliff, and Ellexis Tracy.

At Clearview, Nick Dimacchia is back for his eleventh year as head coach. Last season they had an outstanding 17-5 record. Key returners include Brooke Rebman, Ariana Vazquez, and Vanecia Billings. Dimacchia says they always look to be competitive in

They expect to compete for the PAC title in part because of these four young ladies who return: Alexis Lehmkuhl, Erin Frenk, both seniors, and juniors Jalen Gibbs and Lexi Wright.



2018-2019 High School Wrestling Preview

For the fourth straight season, the Elyria Pioneers will be returning a state champion to their lineup for the upcoming season.

This didn't appear to be the case after two-time state champion Brendon Fenton graduated last season, but the Pioneers welcome senior transfer Jordan Crace, who won the Division II 120-pound state title as a freshman at St. Paris Graham.

Crace, who placed third at 106 as a freshman, enrolled at Elyria in December of 2017, sat the second half of the season to satisfy the OHSAA enrollment requirement, and will be fully eligible to compete his entire senior year.

That's bad news for Elyria opponents, who were already facing long odds against a stacked Pioneers lineup.

Also back are 2018 Division I state runners-up Dylan Shawver and Mick Burnett -- both are two-time state placers -- three-time state qualifier and '18 state placer Matt Zuckerman, state placer Farouq Muhammed, and state qualifier Jake Evans.

Behind them you have district qualifiers in Bryce Allison, Enrique Munguia, Haydon Rockman, Andrew Levis, and Lewis Aguilar.

If that wasn't enough, the Pioneers will also welcome a pair of superstar freshmen -- and program younger siblings -- in Nate Burnett and Peyton Fenton.

The powerful roster gives Elyria a legitimate shot to contend among some of Ohio's best Division I programs, and possibly add that elusive second state championship to the one the Pioneers won in 1973.

The city's other school also has several experienced wrestlers returning. **Elyria Catholic** will be led by three-time Division III district qualifier -- and two-time state alternate -- Steven Ferguson, district qualifiers Aaron Honaker and Jack Decker, and sectional placer Cameron Smith.

The Panthers will be looking to fill their lineup to compete in the Great Lakes Conference, and to send a wrestler to Columbus -- EC came up short last year after a run of five years with at least one state qualifier.

The other county schools that sit alone in their conferences are **Lorain** in the Lake Erie League and **Vermilion** in the Sandusky Bay Conference.

The Titans top returnee is district alternate Brandy Crawford, but several wrestlers have been successful on the middle school level the last couple of years so the program should see an influx of talent.

The Sailors will be led by returning state alternate Jakob Koleszar, district qualifier Brandon D'Egidio, district alternate Levi Jamison, and sectional placer Michael Gergely. Vermilion returns 13 letterwinners, including eight who finished with double-digit victories last season.

Several county schools will be looking to capture a Southwestern Conference title that seems to be up for grabs this season.

The Amherst Comets have a new coach in Vinnie Curiale, who previously coached at Avon Lake and EC, and will be led by district qualifiers Tim Carrion, Clay Carpenter, and Adam Lough. Behind them will be district alternate Noah Mendez and sectional placers Brandon Bratovich, Xavier Rivers, and Jonathon West. Carrion and Rivers won SWC titles last season.

The Comets could have another big boost in Jim Schill, who transferred to his home district after open enrolling at Elyria for three years. Schill, who came to Amherst to play football and hadn't publicly decided if he'd wrestle, was a two-time district qualifier for the Pioneers.

Another team in the SWC mix

will be the **Avon** Eagles, who will be led by two-time district qualifier and 2018 state qualifier Jack Roesch. Behind the 220-pounder will be state alternate Jordan Greer, district qualifiers Cael Saxon, Cade Robertson, and Luke Masisak, district alternate Aaron Endrizel and sectional placer Tyler Hannes.

The Eagles could also get a boost from the return of Tommy Sear -- a district placer as a sophomore and district qualifier as a freshman -- who missed the bulk of last season due to injury.

A team that came on late last season and had a great showing at the SWC tournament was the **Avon Lake** Shoremen, who will be led by two-time district qual-

fier Abud Salem, district qualifiers John Perry and Alec Negron, district alternate Adham Abushukur, and sectional placer Ethan Shepard.

Negron is a two-time SWC champion, while Perry won a conference title last season and Salem and Shepard were SWC runners-up. The program will also receive a boost from several incoming freshmen – Albert Hobar, Lester Jackson, Ethan Danniger, Caleb Moore, Issac Worsencroft, and Hunter McHugh – who were middle school state qualifiers, SWC champs or SWC placers.

Avon Lake has hosted the county's biggest opening weekend tournament for years, but it will no longer be named the Knights of Columbus Invitational going forward. It will now be known as the Cobos Insurance Classic.

The Midview Middies have been one of the SWC's top contenders the past few years but were hit hard by graduation after last season. That doesn't mean the cupboard is bare, as the Middies return three-time district qualifier and 2017 state alternate Zak Anderson, two-time district qualifi-

fers and 2018 state alternates Andrew Philion and Daniel Bucknavich, district qualifiers James Hutchinson and Pablo Cruz, and sectional placer Jameson Shenberger.

The last county team that will battle in the SWC is the North Ridgeville Rangers, who will be led by a quartet of district qualifiers -- Jacob Dunstan, Patrick MacGregor, Abed Sulaiman, and Jared Viancourt.

The other seven county teams compete in the Patriot Athletic Conference and all have a handful of experienced wrestlers returning to help lead their programs and anchor their lineups.

One of the top individual wrestlers in the county will be Firelands junior Payton Burgdorf, who placed fourth in the state as a freshman and placed sixth in the state last season. He will be joined by district alternate Nathan Thompson, 20-match winner Charlie Yonts, and freshman Corey Newark -- a two-time middle school state qualifier.

The Falcons will beef up their schedule this season by adding the Canfield Holiday Duals and the Maumee Bay Classic, and have strengthened their coaching staff with the addition of Zach Sanger -- a Medina resident who excelled in

freestyle and Greco wrestling.

The area's last returning state qualifier is Clearview's Julian Colbert, who advanced to Columbus as a Division III 170-pounder last season. Joining him in the Clippers lineup will be district alternates Donny Horsely and Robert McCurdle.

The Keystone Wildcats will be led by a quartet of district qualifiers in Hudson Hall, Nick Hickman, Brandon Smith, and Randy Hartle. They will be helped out by district alternate Lucas Kincaid and sectional placers Nick

Beriswell and Jose Moralez.

The Wildcats will only have one senior -- Curtis Toth -- in their lineup, and Smith is the lone junior. They will also have a sophomore transfer -- Ryan Healy -- from Oklahoma.

Both Brookside and Columbia return district placers to lead their programs.


The Cardinals are led by two-time district qualifier David Ocasio, who placed at 120 in Division II last season. Joining him will be district qualifier Cody Nusbaum and sectional placers Ethan Garza, John Pickens, and Eric Kebekis.

The Raiders' top guy is two-time district qualifier Justin Bell, who placed at 220 in Division III last season. He also has a strong supporting cast, highlighted by district qualifier Mike Lovell and district alternates Tommy Cassidy, Cody Sestito, Joe Governale, and Elijah Caraballo.

The Oberlin Phoenix are led by twin brothers and district qualifiers Robert and Reggie Bouchonville -- Reggie qualified last season while Robert qualified in 2017. The Phoenix also have a pair of returning sectional placers in Riley Horning and Jerlmiah Sutton.

The final county and PAC team is the Wellington Dukes, who will be led by district alternate Gabe Gayheart and sectional placer Trayton Bowman.

As always, there will be plenty of high-level wrestling on county mats throughout the season, and county wrestlers will travel to some of the top events throughout the state. It'll be enough to satisfy even the greatest high school wrestling fans.



Interview with Bob McElligot

Before coming to WEOL, Matt actually worked in the Blue Jackets organization. Recently, Matt had a conversation with the voice of the Blue Jackets, Bob McElligot, whose colorful calls you can hear throughout the NHL season on AM930 WEOL.

Matt: How did your passion for the game of hockey grow?

Bob: I was born in Pittsburgh and at a young age moved east of the city to Somerset, and growing up, I watched the Penguins, watch them win two Stanley Cups in the early 90's, and hockey really took off for a lot of people in that region, and I developed a real passion for the team and the sport.

Matt: Did you ever think that passion would lead to where you are now?

Bob: I knew from the time I was 11 or 12 years old I wanted to be on the radio. I actually wanted to be a dj. I wanted to be a morning show guy, because it sounded like those guys had the most fun on their jobs. But then I got to high school and while I was a good baseball player, I could catch fly balls and cover ground in the outfield, I couldn't hit, so I knew if I was going to stay into sports, it was going to be through another avenue. I had grown up listening to games on the radio, and I wanted to stay in sports, and I still wanted to be in radio, so it just kind of came together. I love all sports, and I still do high school football on the radio because it keeps me sharp, it challenges me, and reminds me of where I was, how I started, and an appreciation of that kind of work and where I am today.

Matt: Growing up, was there someone you listened to, that you wanted to be like?

Bob: Anybody that listens to the Penguins says I sound like Mike Lange, who's a Hall of Famer and still calls Penguins games on the radio. I don't mean to sound like him as much as I do; he was just engrained in me from an early age. It's really neat that now when we got to Pittsburgh or the Penguins come to Columbus, this is a guy that I idolized from a distance growing up as a boy, and now we're peers. He's just a true gentleman, the way he treats people with total class, and it's what you hope when you're growing up and idolize someone and really admire them, that if you ever meet them, they wouldn't be a jerk, that they would be the person you always thought they were, and Mike Lange is that person.

Matt: How did you become connected with the Blue Jackets?

Bob: I was in Syracuse in the fall of '99 calling the games for the Crunch, who at the time were the farm club of Vancouver. But, it had been determined that the Crunch were going to be the affiliate for Columbus when the Blue Jackets joined the NHL. The timing worked well for me. There was a lot of interaction between the Crunch and the Blue Jackets organizations. On the radio network, I was asked to do a feature for Columbus about what was happening on the minor league level. Then, I was called up to do a couple of Columbus games when former play by play man George Matthews' father passed away, and I was able to meet a lot of people that I had not met face to face and it created a networking opportunity. When the play by play position opened permanently, they came calling again, this time for good.

Matt: From those early years, is there a memorable game or a memorable call that stands out?

Bob: For me, that very first playoff game they won in Pittsburgh on an overtime goal by Matt Calvert, in looking back, it's a piece of history.

They had never won a playoff game until that night, and they really battled, so that one really stands out.

Matt: The fans would all agree, you have some incredible goal calls like "*baloney on the back wall*", and of course "*two words for you...game over!*" Where do you come up with those calls and those sayings?

Bob: That's a Mike Lange thing, and I started doing them in Syracuse because I knew it would fit in the market. I also knew I had to do something different because I was competing against Syracuse University football and basketball programs, so I knew I had to do something to stand out so I thought I would try it. And then, when I was called up to Columbus to fill in for George I wasn't sure if I should do them at the NHL level and I talked to Syracuse head coach Gary Agney, and he said "*Bob, they called you up because of what you do, so do what you do*". I always remembered that so I kept doing them and they've caught on here as well. As far as where I come up with them, they truly just come to me. It could be in a song, a

television show, a movie, or even if my wife or kids say something to me, I'll hear it, and say "*that's it!*" I also try to come up with specific ones for players such as "*yes he Cam*" for Cam Atkinson because that makes them more personal. In the end, I'm on the radio, and I think radio is an entertainment medium, and it should be more fun, so that's what I try to do. It goes back to me wanting to be a morning show dj and have fun on the radio.

Matt: Is there one call that fans seem to like the best or you get the most feedback on?

Bob: Here's the funny thing, I don't know if there is one in particular, but people in general don't tend to get them right. It amuses me, they get the gist of it, and I don't know if that's a knock on me (laughing), but they never seem to get them quite the way I say them. They get the idea though; they're listening and paying attention, so that's all I can hope for.
