Devon Grant: Lorain's Devon Grant dominated the courts in Lorain County during the 2018-2019 high school basketball season on his way to being named Lorain County Mr. Basketball.

During his senior year, The Titans' star posted 650 points, knocked down 31 consecutive free throws, and sank 96 three-point shots while boasting a shooting percentage of nearly 50 percent from behind the arc.

Along with being named Lorain County Mr. Basketball, Grant also took home first-team Division I All-Ohio honors.

This season, Grant will continue his playing career at Miami University in Oxford, Ohio.

Kamryn Dziak: Amherst's Kamryn Dziak was named Lorain County's 2019 Miss Basketball.

During her senior year, the Amherst standout averaged 16.2 points a game and set a new school record by knocking down 74 three pointers.

This year, the former Comet's star will continue her basketball career playing NCAA Division I Basketball at Georgia State University in Atlanta.

Looking forward to another great season!

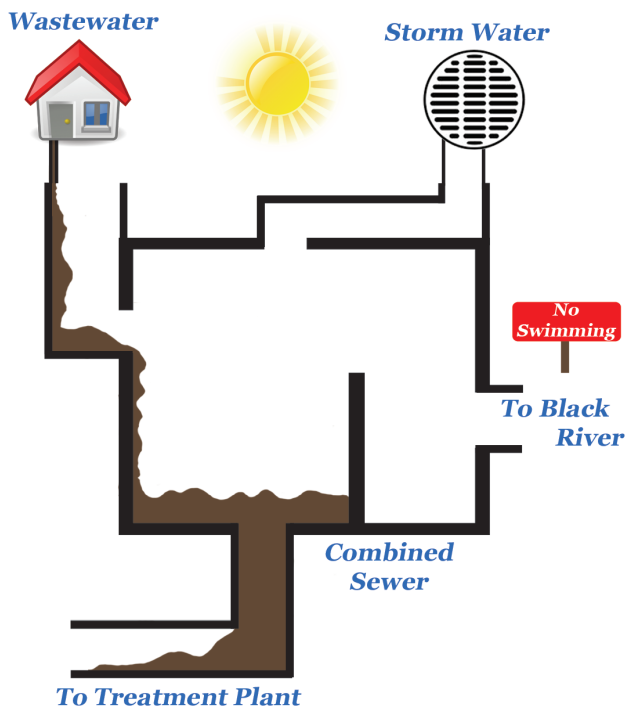

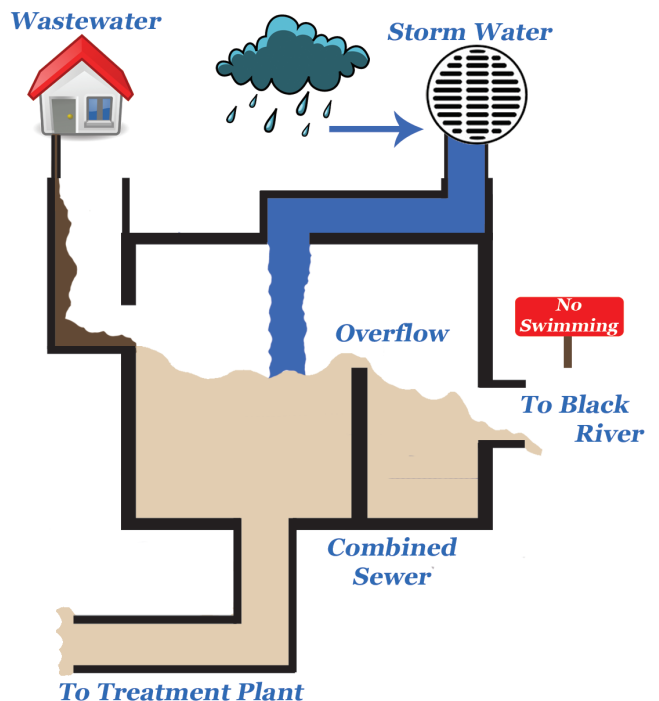

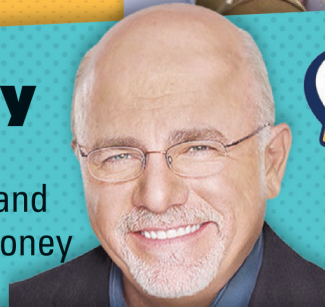

Headed for another great season of hoops

Following another exciting season of High School football in the Lorain County area, it is expected that the 2019-20 academic year will provide plenty of highlights for Lorain County Hoops fans to enjoy for the next few months.

From late November until tournament action begins in the middle of February, the boys hoops scene in Lorain County will offer some new faces with an opportunity to shine and put their respective schools back on the map, or in some cases, keep them there. We'll take a look at all of the area teams and preview the season ahead.

Playing in the Greater Cleveland Conference presents a number of challenges. For the **Elyria Pioneers**, playing that grueling schedule can only help prepare them for the madness that ensues in February. Guard play is expected to be the primary strength for the Pioneers this season, led by MarSaun Robinson, a three-year starter at the position who averaged nearly 14 points per game last season. Senior Aiden Carter is expected to play a big role for the Pioneers as

well in that guard rotation, while junior wing Jahkai Owens and post player Jesse Owens contribute with big minutes as well.

Expectations were incredibly high for the **Lorain Titans** last year, coming off a Final Four run the year before. While the Titans made it all the way to the District Championship, their 60-53 loss to Olmsted Falls was very much unexpected; bringing what was a very exciting season to a heartbreaking close. They'll need to replace the likes of Taevon Pierre-Louis and Lorain County's Mr. Basketball-Devone Grant, among a few others as well. However, the door is open for a host of new players that Head Coach John Rositano is very excited about. Seniors Jordan Jackson and Deonte Benejan are expected to lead the way. Jackson averaged 10 points and six boards per game a season ago, while Benejan averaged 12 and 4 a season ago. The team's primary strengths include depth, athleticism, and the ability to score.

For **Elyria Catholic**, the expectations will be high under second year head coach Rob Palmer. The

Panthers had a strong second half of the 2018-19 season, going 15-10, including a 10-2 mark in Great Lakes Conference play, earning them a conference title. They'll return three starters from a season ago, including Edward Wright, who averaged 15 points and two assists per contest. Altogether, there are eight returning letter winners for the Panthers, on a team that is expected to post another strong season. Coach Palmer believes the strength on this year's team will be their length and their ability to dominate the perimeter.

After winning 39 games over the last two seasons, the **Vermilion Sailors** will experience a lot of roster turnover this season. Replacing Mason Montgomery, a third team All-Ohio performer, among five

others from last year's incredible team that went 10-2 in Sandusky Bay Conference action to claim the league crown will be very difficult. This year's team will be very young and athletic, and Zach Kovach will be counted on to lead the charge. The 6-foot-5 senior center is coming off a season where he averaged 6.5 points per game.

As is the case with every season, the SWC will be extremely competitive and figures to be a bit of a wide open field this season. The **Midview Middies** turned in a .500 season last year, going 11-11 and 9-9 in conference play. Though they only have three seniors, they have a lot of players with a ton of experience coming back, including one of the best

players in the county in forward Jonny Manning, who has drawn some interest from a host of NCAA-II institutions. Manning averaged 15 points and 11 rebounds a game last season, and is regarded by coach Jim Brabanec as a terrific leader. Guard Marcell Young is expected to lead the charge in the backcourt for the Middies.

Avon Lake returns seven letter-winners, including three starters from a season ago. Senior guards Tanner Russell and Nate Sidloski, who averaged 10 and seven points per game respectively last year, are expected to lead the backcourt, while 6-foot-4 post player Nick Marsh, who averaged 10 points and eight rebounds per contest, will be called on to hold things in check down low. Coach Eric Smith is hopeful that this experienced and athletic group

will be right in the heart of the SWC race.

Avon had a real nice 2018-19 season, where they went 15-7 overall and 11-5 in SWC action. They will have some new faces this season, and expect to be right in the middle of a heated conference race. **Amherst** will rely on their athleticism in the front court and solid backcourt play and improve on their 4-17 mark a season ago. **North Ridgeville** hopes to improve on a season where they turned in double digit victories before falling in a sectional title game against Lakewood.

The Lorain County League is expected to provide a lot of fun and excitement as well. **Keystone** Head Coach Jeff Holzhauer is expected to be two big keys for the upcoming season. Keystone is counting on senior guard Ethan

Sokolowski to lead the charge. Sokolowski has two years of starting experience and averaged 10 points, five assists, and two steals per game a year ago. They will need that leadership, as they lost four seniors from last year's team that went 10-6 in conference play.

The **Wellington Dukes** will rely on guard heavy play with hopes of getting up and down the floor quickly. They are coming off a season where they went 11-12 and played .500 (8-8) ball in conference action. They return a trio of senior guards in Ben Bliss, Noah Diermeyer, and Mason McClellan. There are a couple of double digit scorers in that group (Diermeyer-13.4 PPG, McClellan-10.4 PPG) which combined to average 31.2 points per contest a season ago.

Four starters will return for the **Oberlin Phoenix** who are looking to improve on their 6-16 mark from a season ago. They'll return senior Aaron Hopkins, a 6-foot-3 post player, 5-foot-10 sophomore

guard Andre Yarber, 5-foot-9 senior guard Giles Harrell, and 5-foot-9 junior guard Trajen Chambers. Coach Kurt Russell expects quickness, experience and shooting to be the three primary strengths for the Phoenix this season.

The **Columbia Raiders** will look to capitalize on last year's incredible season, which saw them go 16-8, including an 11-5 mark in conference play. There's certainly a lot to replace from a year ago, but Coach Larry Babics is hopeful that senior Charlie Simon and junior Caleb Borling will lead the way. Roster balance and depth are expected to be the primary strengths for the Raiders this season.

While the **Firelands Falcons** only won six games last year, they return four starters on a team that is expected to improve a great deal. The size of the Falcons' frontcourt could make it tough on the competition. The combina-

tion of a pair of 6-foot-6-inch forwards and a talented backcourt will make the Falcons a very tough matchup. Jacob Schmitz and Mitchell Hodges combined to score 21.2 points per game, 12.4 rebounds per game and had 63 blocked shots between them. Size and depth are expected to be the Falcons' strengths this season.

The **Black River Pirates** are looking to improve upon their 6-17 record from a season ago. They'll bring back a pair of starters from last season in Devon McLean and Caleb Simonson. Coach Randy Endsley expects big things from newcomers Gavin Ford and Andon O'Neal. He also believes that defense, quickness, and transition play will be their keys to a successful season.

Clearview is coming off an incredibly successful season a year ago. They lost some good players due to graduation, includ-

ing Javon Todd, who was one of the best players in the area. However, Head Coach John Szalay's teams always seem to find a way.

Brookside hopes to improve under second year head Coach Cory Emerine. They went 6-10 last year to finish fourth in the PAC Stars Division.

Lake Ridge Academy returns four starters from last year's team. Austin Bramhall, Matt South, Ted DeMarco and Ryan Rosu will be expected to help Lake Ridge take a big step in the right direction. Head Coach Alan George expects that this year's team will have a better understanding of their system and improve on last year.

Open Door hopes to have continued success coming off an incredible season where they won 20 games and made it all the way to the District Title game before falling to Richmond Heights. Though they'll have to replace a lot of production from a year ago, the Patriots and Head Coach Kevan Ford hope for another successful season.

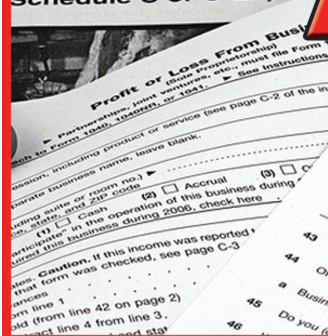

Lorain County Girls Basketball Preview

Just like the previous two seasons, the 2019 – 2020 Lorain County girls basketball season will have three new head coaches on the sidelines. Jessie Bendik at Midview, Rocky Houston at Keystone and Jason Sockel at Vermilion. Let's take a look around the county starting with the Southwest Conference.

Avon Lake has a tough act to follow after an unbelievable season a year ago. The Shoregals went to the regionals and finished 22-4. Dave Zvara was named coach of the year in Division 1 in the state. Top returners include seniors Arianna Negron, Grace Dean, Devan Medved, Lindsay Yurick, and Emily Kirkwood, as well as Juniors Emma Knick, Emily Yarham, and Keely McGinty. Strengths are depth, quickness, experience, and height. Zvara says expectations are that the Shoregals should be competitive in the SWC.

Going south on Route 83, Meghan Larrick has been the head coach at Avon for eleven years. Following last year's 13-10 season, the Eagles will count on the leadership and experience of Senior Ashlee Torbet, a three-year starter. Sophomore Abby Liber will also be vital to Avon's success. Other returners include Juniors Alyssa McClellon, Catie Geiger, Nyah Snezek, Kiley Williams, and Alyssa Peganoff. She is coming back from an injury; they hope she will bring a strong presence to both sides of the court.

Jessy Bendik takes over for Rob Overly at Midview, last year they went 6-17. Top returners include Juniors Isabella Patarini, Autumn Vance, and Jordan Reddinger. Bendik feels the Middies are an up and coming young team with a lot of athleticism. They hope to use that athleticism and competitiveness to challenge some of the top programs in the SWC.

Over at North Ridgeville Amy Esser is in her 12th season as head coach. They finished 11-13 a year ago; top returners include Leia Smith, a senior who averaged 12.3ppg, 2 steals and nearly 5 rpg—and Nina Vlach, with 4.5 ppg and 4.3 rpg. Esser says they are bringing back six varsity players that played a lot last year including

three sophomores: Ryan Elbert, Daylan Barker, and Bella Ramsey. Esser says they have a good mix of veteran players and youth who got valuable experience as freshmen last year.

At Amherst Jay Valadez is back for his second year, they are coming off a 15-8 campaign. Returning from that team are Amaya Staton, Faith Lewis, Lexi Alston, and Anna Cairns. Coach is expecting big things from Staton on both sides of the floor. The Comets will have a defensive mindset and expect defense to be its identity.

Let's take a look at the new Lorain County League. The LC8 are comprised of 8 of the former 12 teams from the defunct PAC conference. Dave Kudela is in his 18th year at Firelands, last year they went 13-11 and had a big tourna-

ment win at Rocky River. Kudela says he has a great nucleus back with three seniors, three juniors, and a sophomore. Experience and team size will be strengths for the Lady Falcons.

Over at Keystone, for the first time in over two decades Scott Terry won't be on the Wildcat sidelines. Rocky Houston comes from the boys program to guide the Lady Wildcats. The only returning starter is Senior Alexis Bowen, also returning are Junior Jayden Whitacre and sophomores Kennedy Kerr and Lily Cassell. Houston is also counting on freshman Delaney Peters. The Cats lack varsity experience, Houston is counting on their athleticism, work ethic, and competitiveness to help offset that lack of experience.

At Clearview, Nick Dimacchia is

in his 12th year. Last year, the Clippers went 12-11 and dealt with a lot of injuries. This year Coach says they have to work hard and play as a team. Key returners include Seniors Ariana Vazquez and LeAnna Rogers, Juniors Brooke Rebman, Olivia Romes, and Arriana Noble, and Sophomores Madison Pennington and newcomer Kamia Pilson.

At Wellington, Nathan Morris is back for his 5th season. Last year was another outstanding season for the Lady Dukes, as they went 16-7. Morris has four starters back from that team: Jalen Gibbs (16ppg and 8rpg), Lexi Wright (8ppg and 50 3's), Amanda Spiekerman, and Brooklinn Damiano. Morris said the goal is to compete for the LC8 Title.

At Brookside Coach Brad Barhorst is in his 5th season, last year they went 11-11, top returners are sophomore Jenna Rothman (7ppg and 12rpg), and Junior Sarah Torres (5ppg).

A look at Lorain County Wrestling

The Lorain County high school wrestling season will begin with multiple returning state champions, a feat that has only happened once over the past two decades when Elyria's Ben Darmstadt and Kevin Vough won titles as underclassmen in 2015.

Elyria's Mick Burnett will begin his senior year after winning the 132-pound state championship last season less than an hour after teammate Peyton Fenton became the first Pioneers freshman to win a state title.

The pair will highlight a roster that is filled with world class wrestling talent.

Burnett is a three-time state placer as is fellow senior Dylan Shawver, who was a state finalist in 2018. Other returning state placers include sophomore Nate Burnett (fifth last season), junior Enrique Munguia (state runner-up), junior Jake Evans (fourth) and senior Bryce Allison (seventh).

Mick Burnett, who will wrestle at Pitt next year, went unbeaten during the postseason last year, placed at Ironman, Beast of the East and Brecksville and won a Greater Cleveland Conference championship. He was a Division I state runner-up as a sophomore and placed sixth as a freshman. He was a Junior national runner-up at Fargo this summer and placed fifth at the preseason Super 32 tournament in North Carolina last month.

Evans also placed (sixth) at the



Avon's Jordan Greer.

Super 32, while Munguia lost in the match to place. Nate Burnett placed third at the USA Wrestling Preseason Nationals, making him a two-time All-American at the event, incoming freshman Jonathan "JoJo" Norwood placed eighth at the event and Colin Noel and Izzak Pedraza also competed at the event. Noel, a Junior freestyle national qualifier, also advanced to the match to place at the tough Michigan Grappler event this preseason.

Other Elyria wrestlers who qualified to the nationals in Fargo last summer include Fenton, Nate Burnett, Shawver, Munguia and incoming freshmen Vinnie D'Alessandro, Erich Trinski and Norwood.

Elyria will get extra support from returning district placer Ben Doeher, one of the Pioneers' top football players, and transfer Brandy Crawford, a district qualifier at Lorain High last season.

The Pioneers will be looking to

capture their fifth straight GCC title and earn a national ranking for the sixth straight year. They have advanced to the dual team state tournament the last five years – finishing as the Division I state runner-up in 2016 – and have five straight top-five finishes at the individual state tournament – including three straight runner-up finishes from 2015-17.

Avon returns after winning a

Southwestern Conference championship and will be led by a pair of state placers – Jordan Greer finished fourth last season while Cael Saxton finished eighth. Both wrestlers won at least 40 matches and won season-opening Cobos Classic titles and SWC titles. Saxton was a Junior freestyle national qualifier this summer.

The pair will have plenty of help this season thanks to district placers Ethan Sear and Mason Bingham, two-time district qualifier Cade Robertson and Junior freestyle and 16u Greco national qualifier Ty Daugherty. Avon also has a pair of incoming freshman – Mason Fitch and Riley Atkins – that qualified to the middle school state tournament last season.

Midview will have probably the most dominant big man on its roster as heavyweight Daniel Bucknavich placed fifth at the Division I state tournament last season after winning 46 matches and winning titles at the district tournament, SWC, MIT, Bill Dies and Comet Classic. He was a state alternate as a sophomore and district qualifier as a freshman.

Other top Middies wrestlers include Andrew Philion – a three-time district qualifier who was a state alternate as a sophomore and district placer last season – two-time district qualifier James Hutchinson, sectional placer Colton Bell, Junior national Greco qualifier Jameson Shenberger, Dustin Wells and Zac Gill.

The other exciting preseason news surrounding Midview is that the school will host an additional Division I sectional tournament this season and all the Lorain County big schools will be in the field.

Amherst has 18 of its 21 wrestlers from last season back, including 2018 district qualifier Clay Carpenter, a district alternate last season, and sectional placers Brandon Bratovic and Xavier Rivers. The Comets won't have junior Jon West, who suffered an ACL injury during the football season, but do have two other juniors – Mackie Perdue and Noah Mendez – who are back after not wrestling during their sophomore seasons.

Comets coach Vinnie Curiale said he also is excited about sev-

eral incoming freshmen, including Eli Mendez, Braden Carpenter, Dominic Kinder and Bishop Fryson.

Avon Lake will be led by two-time district qualifier John Perry, while new coach Scott Sedlick – a Division III state champion for Wellington in 1992 – said Ty Taggart also has a good shot at earning a trip to Columbus this season.

North Ridgeville also has a new coach, Joel Melvin, heading into the season and will be led by sectional placer Dustin McElhaney, while the remaining Division I program in the county, Lorain, will be led by district alternate Xavier Santiago.

The premier Division II wrestler in the county will be Firelands senior Payton Burgdorf, a three-time state placer and Junior freestyle and Greco national qualifier. Burgdorf won 48 matches last year while winning MIT, Edison and Patriot Athletic Conference championships.

The Falcons will be helped by district qualifier Bryce Keown, district alternate Corey Newark and sectional placer Seth Robinette. They will also have a trio of incoming freshmen – Ruben Pina-Lorenzana, Connor Rogers and Weston Strader – who were middle school state qualifiers. Pina-Lorenzana was also a freestyle and Greco national team member this summer.

Firelands will have its hands full in the new Lorain County League and at the Division II postseason tournaments with Keystone, which has seven returning district qualifiers.

Leading the way will be two-time district qualifier Brandon Smith, and Fargo national qualifiers Luke Moore, Nick Hickman and Ryan Healy. Hickman and Moore are returning PAC champions.

The other district qualifiers in the Wildcats lineup are Nick Beriswill, Cody Greene and Jose Moralez, while Austin Sennhenn was a district alternate last season.

Vermilion, which usually begins at a Northwest District sectional tournament before rejoining the other county Division II schools at the district tournament, will be led by three-time district qualifier Brandon D'Egidio and district qualifier Chris Bennett, who was a 16u Greco national qualifier this summer.

The Sailors will also be aided by district alternate Joey Serfoso and sectional placer Owen Gear.

The final Division II county program is Brookside, which will join Firelands and Keystone in the new LCL.

The Cardinals will be led by district qualifiers Eric Saddler and Tyler Warren, district alternate Bryson Cashell and sectional placer Daniel Davis. The Cardinals also shook up their leadership as Seth Houston, who has run the program the last three years, and assistant Andrew Smith have switches places.

Another new county coach will be Columbia's Daniel Juliani, who will have a solid core of wrestlers for his first season.

The Raiders will be led by district qualifier Elijah Caraballo, who went 2-2 at the Division III district tournament, sectional placer Joe Governale, Josh Hickman, who won 36 matches last year as a freshman but was sidelined with an injury during the postseason, and team captain Hunter Smith.

Columbia, which has 18 wrestlers on its roster, has four incoming freshman who were

middle school state qualifiers -- Cole Shulke, a two-time state qualifier who placed fifth at the event last season, Hayden Garrow, also a two-time state qualifier, Tony Governale and Garrett Szuch.

Black River will be a tough opponent for the Raiders in the LCL and Division III postseason. The Pirates will be led by two-time district qualifiers Hunter Yeaples and Jamie Kiousis, district alternates Brandon Rollin and Travis Owen and sectional placers Nick Orellano and Kyle Stevanus. They will also have Noah Orellano, who was a district qualifier in 2017.

Wellington will also be in the LCL and D-III mixes. The Dukes have a quartet of district qualifiers – Trayton Bowman, Jeremiah McKee, Derrick Andolsek and Gabe Gayheart – and a pair of district alternates – Jason Keenan and Michael Hartman – to build their lineup around.

Oberlin will have district qualifier Riley Horning and sectional placer Fallon Cook returning, while the final Division III county program, Clearview, will be led by sectional placer Oscar Rivera.

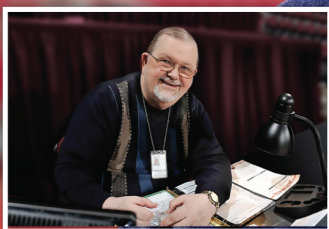
